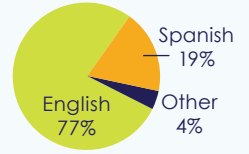
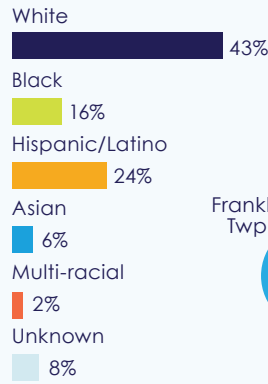

Primary Languages

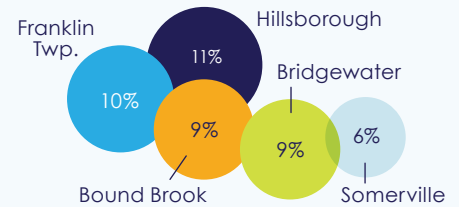


Race/Ethnicity

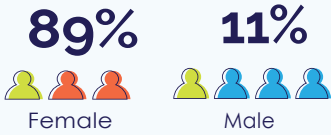


Top Municipalities

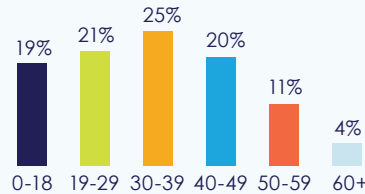

THE NEED

1 in 3 women Will experience domestic violence during her lifetime.

1 in 4 men Will experience domestic violence during his lifetime.

57% of teens know someone who has been physically, sexually, or verbally abusive in a dating relationship.

85% of survivors of domestic abuse experience post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD).

98% of survivors of domestic abuse experience economic abuse.

1.5 million high school students nationwide experience physical abuse in a dating relationship every year

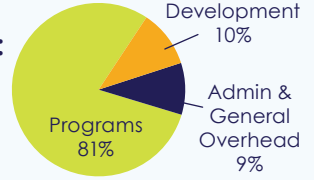

SERVICES

321 individuals volunteered for **4,577 hours**, providing direct services to clients and participating in projects and events. The value to S+SS of these volunteer hours is **\$125,592** or the equivalent of 2.5 full-time employees.

1,196 (**≈12,000 lbs.**) Bags of Food, Toiletries & Household Items were distributed to our clients through our Pantry.

48 of our younger survivors experienced the fun and freedom of summer camp.
